

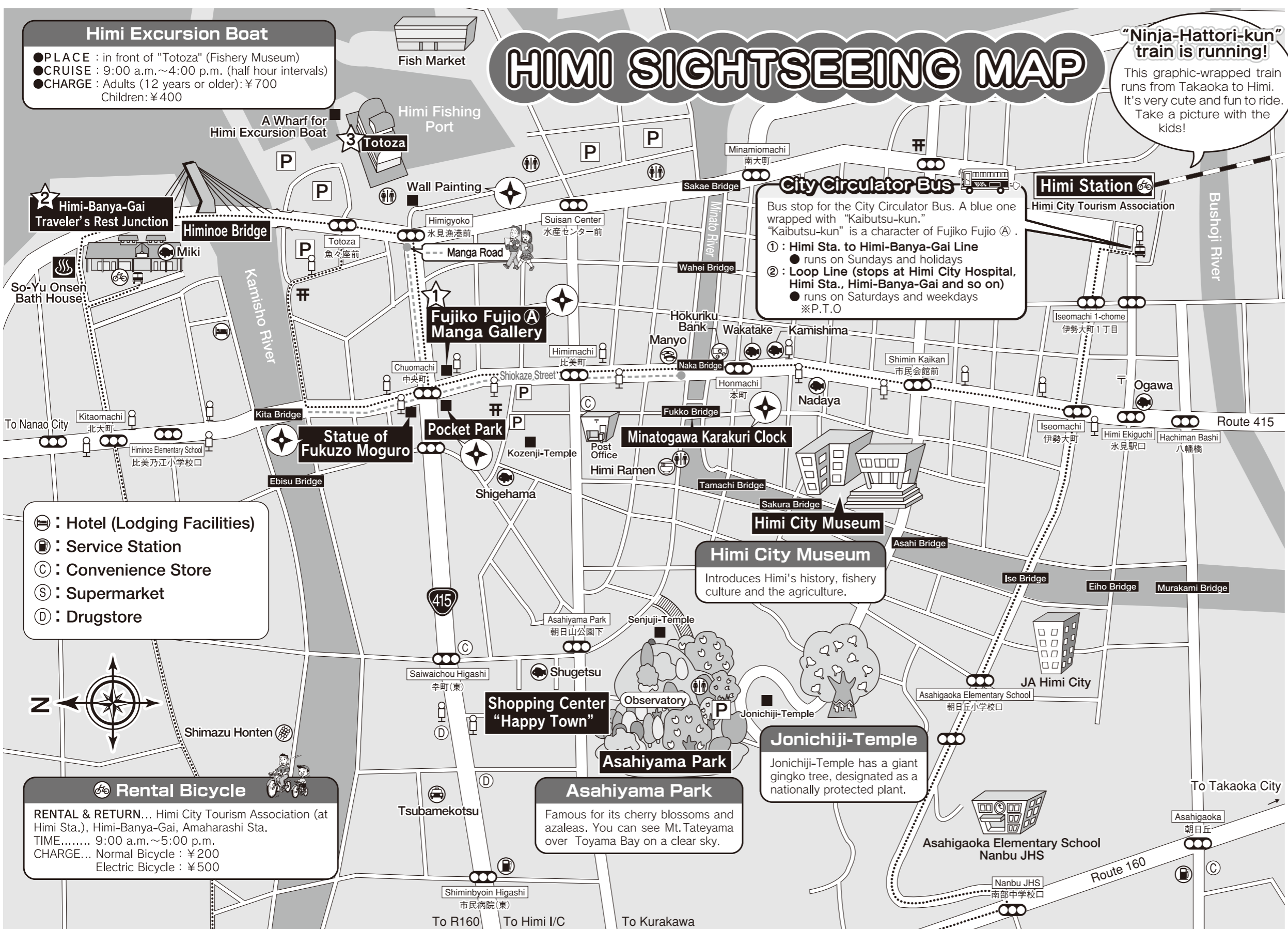
HIMI SIGHTSEEING MAP

"Ninja-Hattori-kun" train is running!

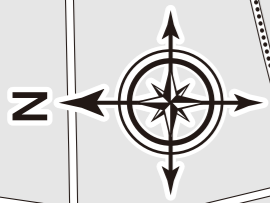
This graphic-wrapped train runs from Takaoka to Himi. It's very cute and fun to ride. Take a picture with the kids!

 Bus stop for the City Circulator Bus. A blue one wrapped with "Kaibutsu-kun."
 "Kaibutsu-kun" is a character of Fujiko Fujio (A).
 ① : Himi Sta. to Himi-Banya-Gai Line
 ● runs on Sundays and holidays
 ② : Loop Line (stops at Himi City Hospital, Himi Sta., Himi-Banya-Gai and so on)
 ● runs on Saturdays and weekdays

1 Who is Fujiko Fujio (A)?
 Fujiko Fujio (A) is a famous cartoonist from Himi. (He created "Ninja Hattori-kun") and other comics. Look for his characters around town!
Minatogawa Karakuri Clock : Characters of "Ninja Hattori-kun" appear every hour on the hour! (Closed in Winter)
Cute Monuments of Fish : There are some cute statues on the Shiohaze Street, designed by Fujiko Fujio (A).
Kozenji-Temple : The temple where Fujiko Fujio (A) was born. Four stone statues of his characters welcome you as you enter the temple gate.
Statue of Fukuzo Moguro : Fukuzo Moguro is a character from "A Laughing Salesman." He wears black suits, and his grin makes us shudder.
Pocket Park : Pocket Park is a rest station. If you need to rest, this is a great space to do so. Restrooms are also available.

2 Himi-Banya-Gai & So-Yu
 Himi-Banya-Gai is a roadside rest area. This facility has restaurants, souvenirs and fresh fish stores. You can get a feeling of Himi in terms of food.
 So-Yu is next to Himi-Banya-Gai. It has a variety of baths fed by hot spring, and sauna. Very restorative after a long day!
 Time required On foot...25 minutes
 By bicycle...10 minutes

3 Totoza (Fishery Museum)
 Himi City is famous for its fishery. We catch a lot of fish throughout the four seasons. This museum introduces the culture of our fishery in Himi. You'll see a big fixed fishing net, called "Teichi-Ami" and an old style boat.
